FROM THE CANTOR



The High Holidays are "early" this year, arriving so soon after Labor Day. There are lots of things to do to prepare, and a dedicated group of our fellow congregants has been busy at work with the many tasks that need to be done. A *yasher koach* to them all!

Now, you may be wondering: Why do the holidays arrive early in some years, and late in others? Why will we be celebrating this year Hanukkah together with Thanksgiving?

The answer is, of course, that our Jewish calendar is based on a lunar cycle that yields 354 days, eleven less than the solar calendar. It therefore brings the holidays closer each year, until that is, we insert an extra month of Adar II in the leap years that occur seven times in every nineteen-year cycle. If not for that adjustment, we would be sitting down for the Pesach Seder some years in the midst of the winter cold or the heat of summer!

But whether the holidays are early or late, our task is to be ready, and I mean, especially, from a spiritual perspective. It is not easy to transition from vacation time one week to the intensity of the Days of Awe the next. The daily recitation of the 27th Psalm and the blasts of the shofar during the month of Elul help in that

regard, but a little extra focus and intention on our part is also required. If we make the effort, the reward is a holiday experience that is more meaningful and elevating.

As we begin the New Year 5774, I wish to extend to the TBOBT family my best wishes for a year that is filled with the blessings of good health, happiness and peace.



On September 13, school bells will again be ringing here at Temple Beth O'r/Beth Torah.






